ORDER

As per the Government Orders read above, the time limits prescribed between the date of publication of tender notice in News papers and the last date for submission of tenders are as follows:

| (i) Works costing upto Rs. 2 lakhs | - 5 days |
| (ii) Works costing Rs. 2 lakhs to 15 lakhs | - 10 days |
| (iii) Works above 15 lakhs | - 20 days |
| (iv) For works which require pre-qualification tender | - 28 days |

2. It has come to the notice of Government that the above periods allowed for the submission of tender is too long and it is one of the main reasons for the delay in awarding the works. A large number of public works, especially those for the repair of damaged roads, are to be arranged urgently before the end of the current financial year.

Considering the urgency of the matter, Government are pleased to order that the period prescribed for submitting tenders shall be limited^{to} 14 days in the case of pre qualification works and 7 days in the case of other works after publication of the tender notices in the news papers during the current financial year.


