**ORDER NO.E3/2000/08/CE/LSGD(2) DATED : 28.04.2009.**

Government vide GO cited 2<sup>nd</sup> created a new Engineering Cadre for LSGD by drawing technical staff from various sources mentioned therein. The special Rules for this cadre was issued as per GO cited 3<sup>rd</sup> and notified as Extra Ordinary Gazette.

Government issued guidelines for the creation of the LSG Engineering Cadre as per GO cited 4<sup>th</sup>. As per the GO the Chief Engineer, PWD and Irrigation and Administration were directed that if sufficient number of willing hands are not received through options, the balance number should be filled up from the junior most from the particular category to maintain the required strength as per GO cited Ist. As such Government absorbed 22 numbers of junior most Assistant Engineers from Irrigation Department and this office issued posting orders to these officers excluding those obtained stay orders from the Hon'ble High Court till the date of issue of the order cited 7<sup>th</sup>. Now the Hon'ble High Court vide judgement cited 6<sup>th</sup> disposed various writ petitiones filed by the junior most Assistant Engineers and the stay orders are vacated.

In the judgement Hon'ble High Court directed the competent authorities to issue posting orders to these officers in appropriate places in accordance with the requirements and in exigencies of service. This is the time of preparation of various developmental schemes and projects in Grama Panchayats for the current financial year. Most of the Grama Panchayat are facing acute shortage of technical staffs especially Assistant Engineers.

In the above circumstances 10 Junior most Assistant Engineers absorbed from Irrigation Department as per GO cited 2<sup>nd</sup> and obtained stay orders before and after the

issue of the order cited 7<sup>th</sup> are hereby posted to the stations noted against their names in the annexure in appropriate places in accordance with the requirements and exigencies of service.

Requests for suitable posting received from the officers are considered to the extent possible. Others are posted to the nearest places available now and as per the requirements of the Local Self Government Institutions. Due to non availability of posts in the southern Districts, some of them are posted to the nearest available vacancies. Their requests will be considered as per their choice at the earliest according to seniority norms and occurrence of vacancies.

Two copies of the posting orders are being sent to the concerned individuals. One copy is to be produced before the relieving officer.




